John Chapter 19

The 43rd book of the Bible. (2/3)

This momentous event occurred in 4 B.C. It was planned in detail before the foundation of the world. This is not something that happened by chance.

This fourth cross is the greatest and most important of them all.

Pilate flogged Jesus 1

Here is the provision for our physical healing.

The stripes that brought bruising to Him, bring healing to us.

By His stripes we are healed. **1 Peter 2:24**

This is why we partake of the bread in Communion

39 stripes: 39 root major causes of diseases!

He delivered Him up - They took Jesus 16

Bearing His cross - Of a Skull - Golgotha 17

Jesus

They crucified Him - Two others with Him -
Jesus in the middle 18

Jesus

Pilate wrote a title - Jesus the Nazarene, the King
of the Jews 19

Jesus

Written in Hebrew, Greek and Latin 20

Jesus

Do not write 21

What I have written, I have written 22

Jesus

Garments in four parts - Tunic - Seamless -
Woven 23

Jesus

Not tear - Cast lots - That the Scripture might be fulfilled - **Psalm 22:18** (Cross) 24

Jesus

Mother – Mary (3) - Stood by the cross 25

Jesus

Woman, behold your son! 26

Jesus

Behold, your mother! 27

Jesus

..... that the Scripture might be completed -
Jesus said, I thirst - **Psalm 69:21** 28

Jesus

..... filled a sponge with vinegar - hyssop -
mouth 29

Preparation - Legs might be broken 31

Garden - And a new tomb - no one yet ever had
been placed - 41

Because the Preparation - Because the tomb was
near - they put Jesus 42

Jesus

33 lines of prophetic Scripture were fulfilled in the last 24 hours of Jesus' life.

There are 332 prophecies in the Old Testament concerning the first coming of the Lord Jesus Christ. He fulfilled every one of them! There is no other source of information except the Hebrew Bible!

The chances of the crucifixion being a random event are excluded by astronomical factors.

Jesus

- If you were to cover the state of Texas (U.S.A.) with silver dollars two feet deep, stirring them thoroughly, mark one of them and then blindfold a man instructing him to find the marked dollar, his chances of finding it would be 1 in 10^{17} . That is one chance in 100 quadrillion! [100,000,000,000,000,000] And this is precisely the chance that the Hebrew prophets had of penning just eight prophecies and having them all come to pass in one man!

There are over 2,000 Scriptures relating to His second coming.

In fact, the Bible mentions more about this time more than any other period in history – including the ministry of the Lord Jesus.
