Beginning of months 2

New birth

John 3:7 Do not wonder because I said to you,
You must be generated from above.

2 Corinthians 5:17 So then if anyone *is* in
Christ, *that one* is a new creation; the old things
have passed away; behold, all things have come
to be new!

Moses and The Passover

Lamb kept four days 3, 6

John 1:29 *On* the next day, John sees Jesus coming toward him and said, Behold! The Lamb of God, the *One* taking away the sin of the world!

1 Peter 1:18-20 knowing that not with corruptible things, silver or gold, were you redeemed from your worthless way of life handed down from *your* fathers,

19 but with precious blood of Christ, as a lamb without blemish and without spot,

20 indeed having been foreknown **before *the* foundation of *the* world**, but revealed in *the* last times because of you,

Moses and The Passover

Revelation 5:6 And I saw, and behold, in *the* midst of the throne, and of the four living creatures, and in *the* midst of the elders, *was* a Lamb standing, as having been slaughtered, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God, having been sent out into all the earth.

Isaiah 53:7 He was oppressed, and He was afflicted, but He did not open His mouth. He was led as a lamb to the slaughter; and as a ewe before her shearers is mute, and He opened not His mouth.

2 Peter 3:8 But let not this one *thing* escape your notice, beloved *ones*, that one day with *the* Lord *is* “as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day.” *Psa. 90:4*

Moses and The Passover

A lamb for a house 4

Acts 16:31, 34 And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and you will be saved, you and your household.

34 And bringing them up to the house, he set a table before *them*, and exulted wholehousely, believing God.

Moses and The Passover

Lamb without blemish 5

1 Peter 1:19 but with precious blood of Christ, as a lamb without blemish and without spot,

Matthew 27:4 saying, I sinned, giving over innocent blood. But they said, What *is it* to us? You see *to it*.

Matthew 27:54 But the centurion and those with him guarding Jesus, seeing the earthquake and the things taking place, *they* feared exceedingly, saying, Truly this *One* was Son of God.

Moses and the Passover

Luke 23:13-15, 22 And Pilate, having called together the chief priests and the leaders and the people,

14 said to them, You brought this Man to me as perverting the people. And, behold, examining Him before you, I found no cause *of death* in this Man *regarding that* which you bring charge against Him.

15 But neither did Herod, for I sent you up to him; and, behold, nothing worthy of death is done by Him.

22 And a third *time* he said to them, For what evil *thing* did this *man* do? I found nothing *as cause of death* in Him; therefore scourging Him, I will release *Him*.

Moses and the Passover

Genesis 3:21 And Jehovah God made coats of skin for the man and his wife, and clothed them.

Genesis 22:13 And Abraham lifted up his eyes and looked. And behold! A ram behind *him* was entangled in a thicket by its horns. And Abraham went and took the ram and offered it for a burnt offering instead of his son.

Moses and The Passover

Whole assembly required to kill it 6

John 19:15 But they cried out, Away, Away!

Crucify Him! Pilate said to them, Shall I crucify your King? The chief priests answered, We do not have a king except Caesar.

Luke 22:23 And they began to discuss with themselves who then it may be of them, the *one* being about to do this.

Moses and the Passover

Romans 5:6-10 for we yet being without strength, in due time Christ died for ungodly *ones*.

7 For hardly anyone will die on behalf of a righteous *one*, (for perhaps anyone even dares to die for the sake of the good *one*),

8 but God demonstrates His love to us in that we being yet sinners, Christ died for us.

9 Much more then, having been justified now by His blood, we shall be saved from the wrath through Him.

10 For if *while* being hostile *ones* we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life;

Moses and The Passover

Lamb slain in the evening 6

Mark 15:33 And *it* being *the* sixth hour, darkness came over all the land until the ninth hour.

Moses and The Passover

Threefold application of blood 7

Hebrews 9:14 by how much more the blood of Christ (who through *the* eternal Spirit offered Himself without blemish to God), will purify your conscience from dead works, to serve *the* living God!

John 10:9 I am the door. If anyone enters through Me, he will be saved, and will go in, and will go out, and will find pasture.

Moses and the Passover

Hebrews 9:22 And almost all things are purified by blood according to the Law; and apart from shedding of blood not *any* remission occurs.

Hebrews 10:29 How much worse punishment do you think will be thought worthy *to receive*, the *one* having trampled the Son of God, and having counted common the blood of the covenant in which he was sanctified, and having insulted the Spirit of grace?

Moses and The Passover

Hebrews 13:12 Therefore, indeed, in order that He might sanctify the people by His own blood, Jesus suffered outside the gate.

Acts 20:28 Therefore take heed to yourselves and to all the flock, in which the Holy Spirit placed you *as* overseers, to shepherd the assembly of God which He purchased through *His* own blood.

Moses and the Passsover

1 Thessalonians 5:23 And may the God of peace Himself fully sanctify you, and may your whole spirit and soul and body be kept blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Leviticus 17:11 For the life of the flesh *is* in the blood, and I have given it to you on the altar, to atone for your souls; for it *is* the blood which makes atonement for the soul.

Moses and the Passover

Colossians 1:14 in whom we have redemption through His blood, the remission of sins;

Leviticus 14:14 For it *is* the life of all flesh; its blood *is* for its life. And I say to the sons of Israel, You shall not eat blood of any flesh, for the life of all flesh *is* in the blood; anyone eating it is cut off.

Moses and The Passover

Blood applied to the door with hyssop 22

Ephesians 2:8, 9 for by grace you are saved,
through faith, and this not of yourselves; *it is* the
gift of God;

9 not of works, that not anyone should boast;

John 19:29 Then a vessel full of vinegar was set,
and having filled a sponge *with* vinegar, and
putting **hyssop** around, they brought *it* to His
mouth.

Moses and the Passover

Psalm 69:21 They also gave *Me* gall in My food;
and in My thirst they gave Me vinegar to drink.

Hyssop is a picture of **Faith**

Every Individual Hebrew Must Apply the Blood to
the Door For Protection From the Death Angel

Moses and The Passover

Hebrew must not go out of his house 22

Isaiah 26:20, 21 Come, My people, go in your rooms and shut your doors behind you. Hide *for* a little moment, until the fury passes.

21 For, behold, Jehovah comes from His place to visit his iniquity on *one* dwelling on the earth. On him the earth shall also reveal her blood, and not shall still cover over her being slain.

Moses and the Passover

Galatians 3:29 And if you *are* of Christ, then you are a seed of Abraham, and heirs according to promise.

Moses and The Passover

Flesh of the lamb to be eaten 8

John 6:53 Then Jesus said to them, Truly, truly, I say to you, If you do not eat the flesh of the Son of Man, and drink His blood, you do not have life in yourselves.

Moses and The Passover

Body and blood reveal the Lord's table 8

1 Corinthians 11:26 For as often as you may eat this bread, and drink this cup, you solemnly proclaim the death of the Lord, until He shall come.

Psalms 103:3 *He* who forgives all your iniquities;
who heals all your diseases;

Moses and the Passover

Psalm 105:37 And He led them out with silver and gold; and among their tribes, not one *was* stumbling.

Moses and The Passover

Isaiah 53:4-6 Surely He has borne our sicknesses, and our pains, He bore them; yet we esteemed Him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted.

5 But He was pierced for our transgressions; *He was* crushed for our iniquities; the chastisement of our peace was upon Him, and with His wounds we ourselves are healed.

6 All we like sheep have gone astray; we have *each* man turned to his own way; and Jehovah made meet in Him the iniquity of all of us.

Moses and the Passover

Mark 2:1-12 And again He entered into Capernaum after *some* days. And it was heard that He was in *a* house.

2 And at once many were gathered, so as none any longer had room, not even to the door. And He spoke the Word to them.

3 And they came to Him carrying a paralyzed *one*, being borne by four.

4 And not being able to draw near to Him, due to the crowd, they unroofed the roof where He was. And having dug through, they lowered the cot on which the paralyzed *one* was lying.

5 And seeing their faith, Jesus said to the paralyzed *one*, Child, your sins are remitted
to you.

6 But some of the scribes were sitting there and reasoning in their hearts,

7 Why does this one speak blasphemies this way? Who is able to remit sins, except One, God?

Moses and the Passover

8 And instantly knowing in His spirit that they reasoned this way within themselves,

Jesus said to them, Why do you reason these things in your hearts?

9 Which is easier? To say to the paralyzed *one*, *Your* sins are remitted to you, or to say, Rise up and take your cot and walk?

10 But that you may know that the Son of Man has authority to remit sins on the earth, He said to the paralyzed *one*,

11 I say to you, Rise up and take up your cot and go to your house.

12 And he rose up at once. And taking his cot, he went out before all, so as all to be astonished and glorified God, saying, Never did we see *it* this way.

Moses and the Passover

James 5:14, 15 Is any among you feeble? Let him call the elders of the assembly, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord.

15 And the prayer of faith will save the *one* being sick, and the Lord will raise him up. And if he may have committed sin, it will be forgiven him.

Moses and The Passover

Flesh of the lamb to be roast with fire 8

Hebrews 12:29 for also, “Our God *is* a
consuming fire.” *Deut. 4:24*

Moses and The Passover

Unleavened bread speaks of Jesus, the Bread of Life 15

John 6:48 I am the Bread of life.

Luke 22:19 And having taken a loaf, having given thanks, He broke, and gave to them, saying, This is My body being given for you. This do in remembrance of Me.

Matthew 26:39 And going forward a little, He fell on His face, praying, and saying, My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from Me; yet not as I will, but as You *will*.

Matthew 27:34 they gave Him vinegar mingled with gall to drink. And having tasted, He would not drink.

Moses and The Passover

Partaker's loins to be girded 11

Isaiah 61:10 Rejoicing I will rejoice in Jehovah. My soul shall be joyful in my God. For He clothed me *with* garments of salvation; He put on me the robe of righteousness, even as a bridegroom puts on *his* head-dress, and as a bride puts on her ornaments.

Isaiah 59:17 For He put on righteousness like body armor, and a helmet of salvation on His head. And He put on robes of vengeance *as* clothing; and He put on zeal like a mantle.

Moses and the Passover

Ephesians 6:13-17 Because of this, take up the full armour of God that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having worked out all things, to stand.

14 Therefore stand firm, “having girded your loins about with truth” and having put on the breastplate of righteousness,” *Isa. 11:5; 59:17*

15 and having shod the feet with *the* preparation of the “gospel of peace.” *Isa. 52:7*

16 Above all, taking up the shield of faith, with which you will be able to quench all the darts of the evil *one* having been made fiery.

17 Also, take “the helmet of salvation,” and the sword of the Spirit which is the Word of God; *Isa. 59:17 LXX-Isa. 11:4; MT-Isa. 49:2; LXX and MT-Hos. 6:5*

Moses and The Passover

Shoes upon feet 11

Ephesians 6:15 and having shod the feet with *the* preparation of the “gospel of peace.”

Isaiah 52:7 How beautiful on the mountains are the feet of him bearing good news, making peace heard, bearing good news, making heard salvation, saying to Zion, Your God reigns.

Moses and The Passover

Eaten in the preparation for a journey

Israel's first journey extended for three days and three nights.

Exodus 8:27 We will go into the wilderness, a journey of three days, and sacrifice to Jehovah our God, as He may say to us.

Likewise, the Christian's journey is based on a three day and three night experience:

Moses and the Passover

Matthew 12:40 And even as “Jonah was in the belly of the huge fish three days and three nights,” so shall the Son of Man be in the heart of the earth three days and three nights.

Jonah 1:17 And Jehovah had appointed a great fish to swallow Jonah. And Jonah was in the belly of the fish three days and three nights.

Moses and The Passover

Staff in the hand typifies dependence 11

Genesis 32:10 I am not worthy of all the mercies and all the truth which You have done for Your servant, for I passed over this Jordan with my staff, and now I have become two companies.

Song of Solomon 8:5 Who *is* this that comes up from the wilderness, leaning on her Beloved? I awakened you under the apple tree; there your mother travailed with you; there she travailed; she bore you.

Moses and The Passover

Must be eaten in haste 11

1 Kings 18:21 And Elijah came near all the people and said, Until when are you limping over two opinions? If Jehovah *is* God, follow Him; and if Baal, follow him. But the people did not answer him a word.

Matthew 8:21, 22 And another of His disciples said to Him, Lord, allow me first to go away and bury my father.

22 But Jesus said to him, Follow Me, and allow the dead to bury their own dead.

Moses and The Passover

The Lord's Passover 11

1 John 3:14 We know that we have **passed (over)** from death to life because we love the brothers. The *one* not loving the brother abides in death.

Romans 3:25 whom God set forth *as* a propitiation through faith in His blood, for a demonstration of His righteousness through the **passing over** of the sins that had taken place before, in the forbearance of God,

Moses and The Passover

Firstborn smitten at Passover 12

Romans 6:4 Therefore, we were buried with Him through baptism into death, that as Christ was raised up from *the* dead by the glory of the Father, so also we should walk in newness of life.

Galatians 2:20 I have been crucified with Christ, and I live; *yet* no longer I, but Christ lives in me. And the *life* I now live in the flesh, I live in faith in the Son of God, the *One* loving me and giving Himself over on my behalf.

Moses and The Passover

Token of blood shows Jesus as an atoning sacrifice
13

Romans 3:25 whom God set forth *as* a propitiation through faith in His blood, for a demonstration of His righteousness through the passing over of the sins that had taken place before, in the forbearance of God,

Moses and The Passover

This night is a memorial 14

1 Corinthians 11:24 and having given thanks,
He broke and said, Take, eat; this is My body,
the *one* being broken on behalf of you; this do in
remembrance of Me.

Moses and The Passover

No manner of work to be done 16

John 19:30 Therefore when Jesus took the vinegar, He said, **It has been finished**. And bowing *His* head, *He* gave over the spirit.

Ephesians 2:8, 9 for by grace you are saved, through faith, and this not of yourselves; *it is* the gift of God;

9 not of works, that not anyone should boast;

Moses and The Passover

Great cry at midnight 30

Matthew 25:6 And *in the* middle of night a cry occurred: Behold, the bridegroom comes! Go **out** to meet him.

Luke 11:5 And He said to them, Who out of you shall have a friend, and will come to him at midnight and say to him, Friend, lend me three loaves.

Moses and The Passover

Stranger not allowed to partake 43

Ephesians 2:12-29 that at that time you were without Christ, alienated from the commonwealth of Israel and strangers of the covenants of promise, having no hope and without God in the world.

13 But now, in Christ Jesus you who then were afar off, came to be near by the blood of Christ.

14 ¶ For He is our peace, He making us both one, and breaking down the wall of partition,

15 in His flesh having made to cease the enmity, the Law of the commandments in decrees, that He might in Himself create the two into one new man, making peace,

16 and might reconcile both in one body to God through the cross, slaying the enmity in Himself.

Moses and the Passover

- 17 And coming, *He* proclaimed “peace to you, the ones afar off, and to the ones near.” *Isa. 57:19*
- 18 For through Him we both have access by one Spirit to the Father.
- 19 So, then, you are no longer strangers and aliens, but *you are* fellow citizens of the saints and *of the* household of God,
- 20 being built up on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ Himself being *the* cornerstone,
- 21 in whom all the building being fitly joined together grows into a holy temple in *the* Lord,
- 22 in whom you also are being built together into a dwelling place of God in *the* Spirit.

Moses and the Passover

Romans 2:25-29 For indeed circumcision profits if you practice *the* Law, but if you are a transgressor of Law, your circumcision becomes uncircumcision.

26 Therefore if the uncircumcision keeps the ordinances of the Law, *will* not his uncircumcision be counted for circumcision?

27 And will the uncircumcision by nature, by fulfilling the Law, judge you through *your* letter and circumcision *become* transgressor of Law?

28 For not in the visible *one*, he is a Jew, nor *is* the circumcision in flesh *a* visible *one*;

29 but in the secret *one* is *the* Jew, and circumcision *is* of heart, in spirit, not in letter; of whom

Moses and The Passover

Not a bone of the Lamb to be broken 46

Psalm 34:20 keeping all his bones; not one of them is broken.

John 19:36 For these things happened that the Scripture might be fulfilled, “Not a bone of Him shall be broken.” *Ex. 12:46; Psa. 34:20*

Moses and The Passover

Feast observed where the name of the Lord was recorded

Deuteronomy 16:16 Three times in a year shall all your males appear before Jehovah your God in the place which He shall choose: In the Feast of Unleavened *Bread*, and in the Feast of Weeks and in the Feast of Tabernacles. And they shall not appear before Jehovah empty,

Galatians 6:16 And as many as shall walk by this rule, peace and mercy *be* on them and on the Israel of God.

Moses and the Passover

John 19:19, 20 And Pilate also wrote a title and put *it* on the cross. And having been written, it was: JESUS THE NAZARENE, THE KING OF THE JEWS.

20 Therefore, this title many of the Jews read, because the place where Jesus was crucified was near the city. And it was written in Hebrew, in Greek, in Latin.

Moses and The Passover

Acts 11:26 And finding him, he brought him to Antioch. And it happened that *for* them to be assembled to them in the assembly a whole year. And they taught a considerable crowd. And the disciples were first called Christians at Antioch.

Moses and The Passover

Going down of the sun can only refer to the crucifixion of Christ

Luke 23:44, 45 And it was about *the* sixth hour, and darkness came to be over all the land until *the* ninth hour.

45 And the sun was darkened, and the veil of the temple was torn apart in the middle.

46 And crying with a loud voice, Jesus said, Father, “into Your hands I commit My spirit.”

Amos 8:9 And it shall be in that day, a statement of the Lord Jehovah, that I will make the sun to go out at noon, and I will darken the earth in light of the day.

Moses and The Passover

Egyptians spoiled at Passover

Colossians 2:15 having stripped the rulers and the authorities, He made a show of them in freely speaking, triumphing *over* them in it.

1 John 3:8 The *one* practicing sin is of the devil, because the devil sins from *the* beginning. For this the Son of God was made known, that He might undo the works of the devil.

Moses and the Passover

Hebrews 2:14 Therefore since the children have partaken of flesh and blood, in like manner He Himself also shared the same things, that through death He might do away with the *one* having the power of death, this is, the devil;
