- Why Corporate Anointing?
- When one silver trumpet sounded in the late 1940's and 50's, the princes gathered to receive a mighty anointing of power that wrought miracles and produced thousands of healings.

- The Feast of Trumpets
- Numbers 10:1-10
 - 1 And Jehovah spoke to Moses, saying,
 - 2 Make two trumpets of silver for yourself. You shall make them of hammered work, and they shall be to you for the calling of the congregation, and for causing the camps to pull up stakes.
 - 3 And when they blow with **them**, all the **congregation** shall gather themselves to you at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation.
 - 4 And if they blow with <u>one</u>, then **the rulers**, the **heads** of the thousands of Israel, shall assemble to you.
 - **5** And when you blow an alarm, the camps that lie on the east side shall then pull up.

- 6 And when you blow an alarm the second time, the camps that lie on the south side shall pull up stakes; they shall blow an alarm for their breakings of camp.
- 7 But when the assembly is gathered, you shall blow, but you shall not sound an alarm.
- 8 And the sons of Aaron, the priests, shall blow with the trumpets. And they shall be to you for a never-ending statute throughout your generations.
- **9** And when you go into battle in your land against the adversary oppressing you, then you shall blow with the trumpets, and you shall be remembered before Jehovah your God. And you shall be saved from your enemies.
- 10 And in the day of your gladness, and in your appointed times, and in your new moons, you shall blow the trumpets over your burnt offerings, and over the sacrifices of your peace offerings. And they shall be to you for a memorial before your God. I am Jehovah your God.



- John 13:1-17 [KJ3]
 - 1 And before the Feast of the Passover, Jesus knowing that His hour had come that He should pass from this world to the Father, having loved His own in the world, He loved them to the end.
 - 2 And supper having occurred, the devil already having put into the heart of Judas, the son of Simon Iscariot, that he should give Him over,
 - 3 Jesus knowing that the Father has given all things into *His* hands, and that He came out from God, and He goes to God,

- 4 He rises up from the supper and lays aside *His* garments. And taking a towel, He girded Himself.
- 5 Then He put water into the basin and began to wash the feet of the disciples, and to wipe off with the towel with which He was girded.
- 6 He then comes to Simon Peter. And that one said to Him, Lord, do You wash my feet?

- 7 Jesus answered and said to him, What I am doing, you do not yet know. But you will know after these things.
- 8 Peter said to Him, You may not wash my feet unto the age, not ever! Jesus answered him, If I do not wash you, you have no part with Me.

- **9** Simon Peter said to Him, Lord, not my feet only, but also the hands and the head.
- **10** Jesus said to him, The *one* having been bathed has no need *other* than to wash the feet, but is wholly clean. And you are clean, but not all *of you*.
- 11 For He knew the *one* giving Him over. On account of this He said, You are not all *of you* clean.
- 12 When, therefore, He washed their feet and took His garments, reclining again, He said to them, Do you know what I have done to you?
- **13** You call Me the Teacher, and, the Lord. And you say well, for I AM.

- **14** Therefore if I washed your feet, the Lord and the Teacher, you also ought to wash the feet of one another.
- 15 For I gave you an example, that as I did to you, you also should do.
- **16** Truly, truly, I say to you, A slave [1401] is not greater than his master, nor a messenger greater than the *one* having sent him.
- 17 If you know these things, blessed are you if you do them.

- We are to serve the community
- A great example of the leaders of the three levels of natural (political) government (Mayor of Logan City, The State Member and the Federal Member), working together to serve the underprivileged (poor), was observed by those in attendance at the second annual Lang Christmas Dinner on 11 December, 2009.

- This is the first time leaders of these divisions of government have worked together.
- They did so as servants: serving food to the poor in their community.
- First the natural, then the spiritual.
- God is currently forming a restorational spiritual government for Logan.

- This is a great example of Psalm 133
- Notice specifically the last verse.
- 1 A Song of Ascents. Of David. Behold! How good and how pleasant is the living of brothers, even in unity.
 - 2 It is like the precious oil on the head that randown on the beard, Aaron's beard, going down to the mouth of his garments;
 - 3 like the dew of Hermon coming down on the mountains of Zion; for there Jehovah commanded the blessing: life till everlasting.

- When brethren dwell together in unity God COMMANDS the blessing.
- It is not asked for it is automatically bestowed!
- Life Everlasting.
- We have witnessed a (microcosm) of what is going to break out all over Logan. The city will experience TRANSFORMATION.

Romans 13:1-6

- 1 Let every soul be subject to higher authorities having power, for there is no authority except from God, but the existing authorities have been ordained by God.
- 2 So that the one resisting authority has opposed the ordinance of God, and the ones opposing will receive judgment to themselves.
- 3 For the rulers are not a terror to good works, but to the bad ones. And do you desire not to fear the authority? Do the good, and you will have praise from it;

- 4 for it is a servant of God to you for the good. But if you do the bad things, be afraid; for it does not bear the sword in vain; for it is a servant of God, an avenger for wrath to the one practicing bad things.
- 5 Therefore it is necessary to be subject, not only on account of wrath, but also on account of conscience.
- 6 For on this account you also pay taxes, for they are ministers of God, attending continually to this very thing.
