Observe the downward spiral of Man:

Firstly, he runs - hides from the presence of God

He assumes he can discharge his problem by
running from it

He must not run He must face his responsibility
correctly

Secondly, Fear

The Opposite of Faith

2 Timothy 1:7 For God did not give a spirit of
cowardice to us, but of power and of love and
of self-control.

The Serpent and the Woman

Woman gave it to me 12

Thirdly, he shifts the blame:

It's not my fault; it's this woman you gave me.

Indirectly, Adam is blaming God.

If you never gave me this woman, this would
never have happened.

You Will Never Receive Help From God Unless
You Assume Responsibility For Your Actions

- You are where you are today because YOU have chosen to be there!
- Accept it!
- Don't be full of fear
- Don't shift the blame for Your responsibility
 - It's not my fault I can't help it I was born like it I got bad DNA from my parents.

The Woman was Deceived by the Serpent

- **1 Timothy 2:14** And Adam was not deceived, but *the* woman being deceived has come to be in transgression;

The Man Was Not Deceived. He Did What He Did With His Eyes Wide Open. He Knew Precisely What He Was Doing in Rebellion

Seed of the **Woman** - Bruise the serpent's head -
Serpent bruise manchild's heel

The Hebrew Word is **CRUSH!**

Moses - Jesus - Manchild
